Doctors at Central Vet, of Valley Stream, say the 4-year-old wasn't microchipped, so he had to be quarantined for six months to make sure he didn't have rabies.

Midnight

was released and picked up today by Guardians of Rescue, who took the canine to Save-a-Pet in Port Jefferson to be put up for adoption.
